


Visit Spring Grove House



Saturday 21 September 10am to 4pm Last tour 3.15pm

Spring Grove House will be open to the public as part of Open House London 2019. Tour this beautiful Grade II listed building, set within the campus of West Thames College. Explore the history of the house – from Georgian country estate of Sir Joseph Banks to Victorian mansion of the Pears Soap family and private hospital for wounded soldiers during World War I.
