



Letter from the school JTAs (Junior Travel Ambassadors)

Dear Parents and Children,

Over the last week, the Junior Travel Ambassadors have been conducting a survey by watching cars and pedestrians' movements in Star Road.

Our conclusions are as follows:

1. There were a few drivers who parked outside the local residents' homes to drop off children and in doing so blocked the driveways.
2. There are parking bays in another part of Star Road, first turning on your right. Please use these when dropping off, as it is safer for the other parents and children who are walking into school and more polite to the local residents.
3. Some drivers have started to use this part of the road, however could the following drivers also use this road?

PJ66 SGU, LN55 TKD, 136 D295, FV10 LZM, LX63 P2W, LR55 YJT, GY05 LPI, LC12 YCH, LC56 UOL

4. There were a few times over the 3 survey days that near misses occurred between cars and children and cars and cars. This is something that **MUST** change quickly. Please try not to drive to school, try walking, cycling, scooting or public transport.
5. Pedestrians were also a concern. We saw parents and children walking in the middle of Star Road; crossing diagonally from the left to the right across the main part of the road without looking for cars.
6. We also saw young children running across the road (from the turning on the left) without an adult.
7. This turning on the left is a road and it is used constantly. Please make sure that you are holding your young child's hand when crossing the road to keep them safe.
8. We think that the older children need to be reminded about the Green Cross Code and how to use roads safely. Please go through this with your children at home.

Thank you for reading the results of this important survey and consider making some changes.
