Dear Parents and Carers,

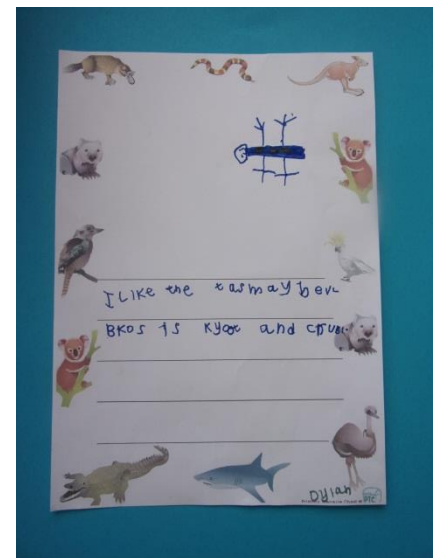
In school as we continue to adapt to our new routines, I wanted to praise all of the children and staff for the resilience and positive outlook that they are showing throughout the day.

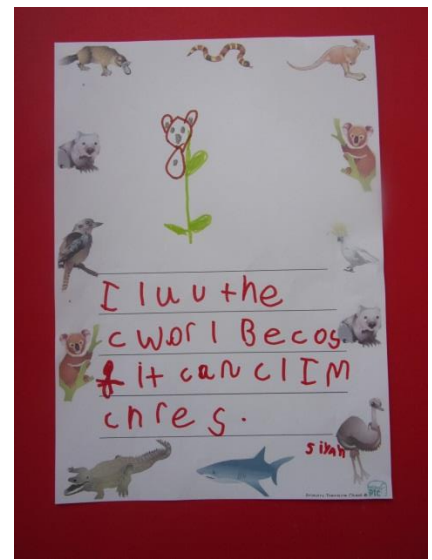
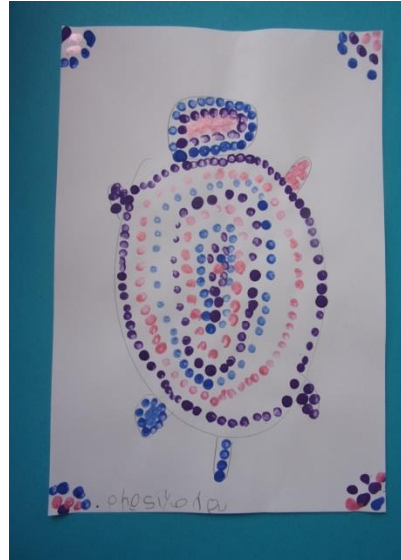
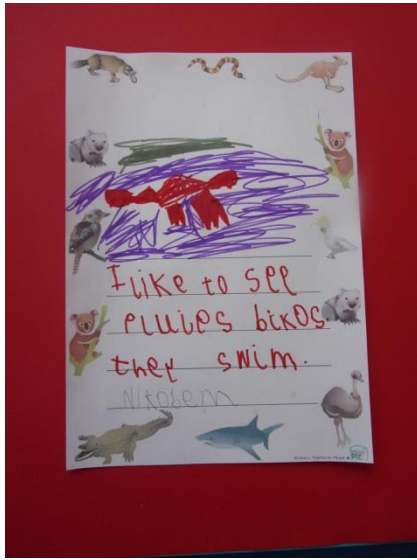
