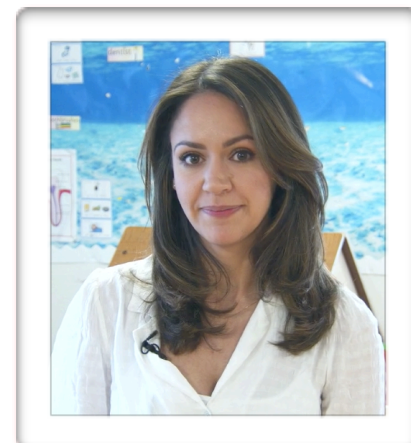


Free Oral Health Promotion Training

The training will convey key oral health messages to anyone working with children (aged 0–19). Topics include:

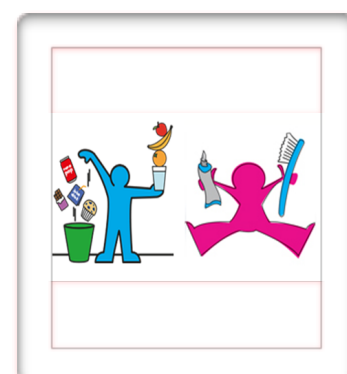
- Brushing tips & techniques
