Key Areas of Learning

As **geographers**, we will compare and contrast the United Kingdom with New Zealand. We will investigate seasonal weather patterns. We will explore and develop our mapping skills using simple fieldwork and observational skills of our local area and explore the continents and seas, including physical and human features.

As **historians**, we will investigate Grace Darling and Sir David Attenborough and explore how their work has influenced our lives today.

As **scientists**, we are explorers, identifiers and describers of living things, plants, people and animals of land, air and sea. We are observers of the changes within seasons and weather.

English

We will focus on a range of grammar including using capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, whilst applying phonic sounds, and rereading to check. We will also be sequencing sentences to form short narratives.

We will also provide opportunities to speak clearly to an audience ask questions and answer them

We will focus on Phonics Phases 3 to 5, do the Phonic Screen Test and Spellings including digraph & trigraph, common exception words, compound words and adding and using the prefix 'un'.

MATHS

We are problem solvers and we will be learning, exploring and solving problems in:

- Number: Multiplication and Division
- Number: Fractions
- Geometry: Position and direction
- Place Value within 100
- Measurement: Money and Time

We are TV Chefs collating photos, filming and collecting data.
