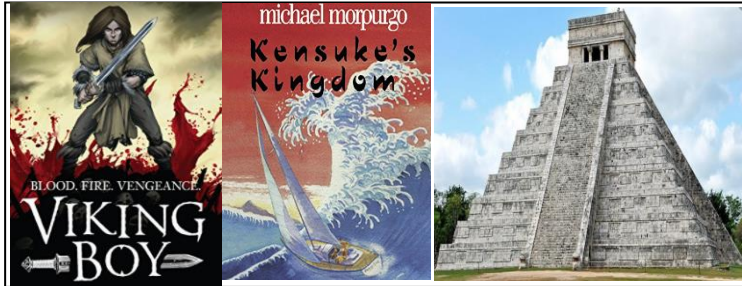


# Kensuke's Kingdom

## Key Areas of Learning
