Key Priority

To close the disadvantage gap by addressing inequalities and raising the attainment of those students in low-income families through:

- Targeted additional support strategies which result in every pupil, however disadvantaged, being able to have full access to our curriculum and all our extra-curricular experiences.
- All pupils who are currently underperforming because of the impact of their disadvantaged background will make improved progress leading to narrowing of any attainment gaps.
- To support pupils with teaching support or additional resources who may be disadvantaged or have not fully engaged in home learning due to Lockdown and COVID.

Areas for Development:

- To ensure all pupils eligible to receive PPG funding in the Early Years are identified and funding claimed
- To ensure that PPG pupils joining the school at low starting points in Reception make accelerated progress to begin to narrow the attainment gap between them and their non-PPG peers
- To reduce the gap between PPG pupils and non-PPG meeting the expected standard in the phonics screening at the end of Year 1
- To close the gap between PPG and non-PPG attainment across reading, writing and maths in KS1 and KS2
