

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know, this week we have been reading the traditional story-Little Red Riding Hood. We have talked about what a character is and identified them in a range of other books. After reading Little Red Riding Hood we began talking about our own Grandparents. Thank you to all those who managed to send in photographs of their child's grandparents, the children really enjoyed talking about the pictures and the fun things they like to do with their grandparents. Finally, we had a visit from Little Red Riding Hood who was very upset as the wolf had tried to eat her Grandma and even had eaten all her cakes! Nursery were very kind and offered to bake her some more- we all had so much fun making some new fairy cakes for her!

To support your child's learning at home this week you could:

- Find a recipe that you would like to make with your child and discuss the ingredients that are needed, you may need to remind your child what the word ingredient means. While making the recipe take some photographs and after look through them recapping what you did first, next and then....
- Look at the other side of this letter for other fun maths activities that you could do with your child at home. As you play the games with a die, try and encourage your child to start to recognise the patterns on the face of the dice. The more you play, the quicker they should be able to identify the number by the spot pattern, as the pattern is always the same!



- When you are reading at home – talk about characters – can the children identify the characters in different stories?

Next week we will be reading Goldilocks and the Three Bears and we will be making porridge as well as going into greater depth exploring the number three. We will think about different characters behaviours and begin to build a profile about them. We will try and answer questions like; *Did Goldilocks make a good decision going into the Three Bears' House?* Finally, we will develop our understanding stranger danger and how to keep ourselves safe.

A gentle reminder, please check your child's school uniform and shoes as we have had a number of parents who have reported missing items of clothing. Could you check that all the jumpers you have at home belong to your child, if you find one with another child's name can you return it to school as soon as possible. Thank you for your support with this. We hope that you have a lovely weekend.
