Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the second part of the Spring Term- we hope you all had a fantastic break. Since returning to school the children have been talking about their adventures which has been great to hear.

This week, we have been thinking about healthy living and we have read some really interesting books: 'Give us a smile, Cinderella', 'Eat your greens, Goldilocks' and 'Blow your nose, Big Bad Wolf!' These stories have prompted discussions in the classroom about the different ways we can stay healthy, make good food choices, how to look after our teeth, how to blow our nose and how to wash our hands effectively. We have also been thinking about how we learn and have had a feast of stories this week to explore the different attitudes to learning that have helped us understand the importance of not giving up, having our own ideas and exploring new things.

To support the children further we are encouraging the children to talk in full sentences, for example: when they are asked a question we are expecting them to say "yes please, Mrs Gratton" or "No thank you, Mrs Gratton". It would be great if you could support us with this at home too by encouraging the children to respond to you in sentences and with manners.

A reminder that next Thursday is World Book Day and we are encouraging the children to dress up as their favourite book character.
