Happy Friday! This week, the children have enjoyed another busy and fun-filled week at school, here is what we have been up to:

Maths

This week, we began by applying our multiplication understanding to tackle some tricky word problems! I was amazed with the perseverance the children showed, even when they made mistakes they continued to try and solve the problem. Towards the end of the week, we started to learn about division and used our multiplication facts to support us. Please complete the attached sheet and continue to support your child with their time tables practise.

Reading

During the school week, all children read with an adult at least once, to support us and your child please ensure their reading books are in their book bag **every day**. I will be signing yellow reading records every **Tuesday and Friday**, so please remember to bring them in! To support developing the children's comprehension skills I will be sending out a reading comprehension activity for homework every two weeks, starting this week.

Phonics

The children have been given an **oxford owl** login to consolidate the phonics they have been learning at school. All activities that are set are matched to the phonics group your child is taught in at school, we ask for you to support your child at home to log on and complete the assigned activity.

Art

The children have been phenomenal artists this week! They have learnt about portraits and self-portraits and began by drawing their partner. They were focussed and made sure that they only drew what they could see- Well done! In the commencing weeks, we will be creating self-portraits and painting themselves in the style of the famous artist Vincent van Gogh.

Science

The children were surprised to see a piece of meat laying on their tables as they entered the classroom and were very excited to investigate it! They were stunned at the fact that the piece of meat was all muscle and that the human body is covered in muscles that look just like the piece of meat on their tables. We learned that when muscles tense and contract it causes our bones to move! We also took a closer look at all the fibres in the muscle.
