Dear Parents and Carers,

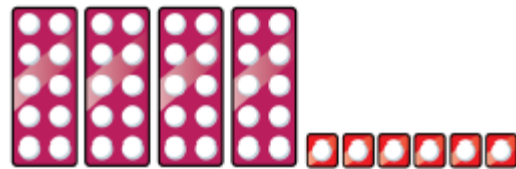
Welcome back and we hope that you have had a good half-term break! Our topic this half term is all about the Victorian era. This week, we have started to look and handle some household items that were used during the Victorian era and have compared them to similar items that we use today. We thought about what the item was made of and how they worked, then we discussed if the item had any changed over time.

We will be having a Victorian Day later in the term and I will share some additional information next week. The children's challenge this half-term is to learn a nursery rhyme off by heart and perform it in front of the class. I will upload a list of Victorian nursery rhymes onto our Google Classroom for you and your child to look at and select a rhyme to learn. Your child can include actions and props as part of their performance if they wish to.

In Maths, we have been representing numbers to 50 using resources looking closely at the amount of tens and ones that are in a given number and have been able to count in tens. We have also learnt to find 1 more and 1 less than a given number and have been comparing amounts of objects up to 50.

At home you might want to try to answer questions like:

- Can you represent the number 46?
- What is one more or one less than 46?
- How many tens and ones are in the number 46?
- Can you count in 10s up to 46?



The main focus during our English lessons this week has been to ensure that we have a capital letter at the start of a sentence, we are using a finger space between words and have used a full stop at the end of a sentence. We encourage the children to reread their written work to ensure it makes sense and to make any changes that are necessary.

Finally, it has been Healthy Living Week this week at school and the children have completed a number of activities that have included creating a collage of drawings that inspire them to be happy!
