Dear Parents and Carers,

What a busy and exciting week we have had in school this week and we would like to wish you a Happy Friday! Thank you to everyone who attended a parents' evening appointment this week, I hope that you found it informative, if you have any further questions then please do come and see me. Please find below a summary of some of our key learning this week and some suggestions of activities you could complete at home to support your child's learning:

#### **Maths**

In Maths, we have continued to learn about the properties of different 2D and 3D shapes. The children have learnt lots of new vocabulary and I have been amazed with their determination to apply the new vocabulary: vertices, dimension, curved face, base, edge and flat face whilst completing their independent activities. We can now recognise the 2D faces on a given 3D shape!

#### **Reading**

In Reading, we have been focussing on developing our inference skills. This skill requires the reader to look for clues in the text, story or poem to help answer a question. Please use the attached sheet whilst reading with your child to help further develop your child's inference skills.

#### **PSHE**

This week in PSHE, we have been learning about what it means to be relaxed and have enjoyed completing some relaxing activities such as listening to calming music, meditation and breathing exercises in class. We have also been looking at a selection of pictures showing different activities and ranking them in order of least relaxed activity to most relaxed activity, this has helped us to understand how important it is to take the time to relax so we can clear our minds.

#### **DT**

On Thursday, we thoroughly enjoyed creating our rockets- it was brilliant to see the perseverance and creativity the children all displayed. Make sure that you look at some of the rockets we have created and I'm sure you will agree we have some promising designers and engineers in the making! Well done to all of you! ☺ In English, we will be writing a recount of our day.

#### **SATs**

A number of parents have been enquiring when the Key Stage One SATs will take place this year. These are a series of assessments in Reading and Maths administered to all Year Two children nationally throughout the month of May. These assessments will be used alongside the independent work produced in class to assess your child's attainment at the end of Key Stage One.

#### **Homework**

To support your child's learning I've attached two tasks for you to complete at home. This week I would like the children to complete the reading comprehension and maths task.
