Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a bitty week and yet the children have worked really hard. In Science, we have been identifying and learning the function of different parts of a flowering plant and what factors a plant needs to grow. The children have also had the chance to explore the school grounds searching for common plants that you would find at home in the garden, the park and our school.

In Maths, the children have been investigating equal groups and explaining to each other how they knew a group was equal or not equal. As a class we have discussed how we can make an unequal group equal and have realised that there is more than one way. At home to support your child's learning you could sort clothes on a washing line, or any other items that you may have at home, into groups of equal amounts. We have also been investigating arrays, a set that show equal groups in rows and columns, can you identify the equal groups in the examples below?



At home you can support your child's leaning by spotting arrays at home, in the street or in the shops. Have lots of fun spotting them.

From next week, I will be sharing links for phonics sounds, reading tasks and spelling activities on our Google classroom. Please watch these videos with your child as they will help to develop their confidence in these areas.
