Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, in Maths we have been revising our understanding of multiplication and have been representing a multiplicative statement as a repeated addition statement, for example:  $2 \times 4 = 4 \times 2$ , which can be represented as  $4 + 4$  or  $2 + 2 + 2 + 2$ . We have also been learning about doubling and have been finding the total of pairs of numbers up to ten. Some children even noticed that when you double a number the total is an even number. At home to support your child's learning you could share an amount of items into two groups making sure that they are equal. Can you find out which amounts cannot be shared into two equal groups?

The children have also been using iPads to record each other and have been trying hard to keep them still and focused- well done everyone! We hope that with the children's improved filming skills they would be able to record each other making a milkshake very soon. At home to support your child's presentation skills you could select a recipe from a recipe book and pretend to make it in front of a camera, describing what you are doing and thinking how you can make your presentation entertaining for the audience.

We have also started our own *bean diary* in Science after planting our own beans, we are now waiting for them to start growing. During our topic sessions, we had started to identify two types of trees, deciduous and evergreen, and now we are beginning to be able to recognise a leaf from a deciduous or evergreen tree. If you get a chance over the weekend and the weather is suitable please could your child collect some leaves to bring in to school so we can discuss and sort them.

Once again, thank you for your child's baby photo but if you haven't already sent one in please could you by Wednesday. The children will be using their pictures for a game of guess who on Friday as well as looking at them to identify any changes that have taken place since the picture was taken. We are also still collecting pringle size cardboard tubes, if you have any at home can your child please bring them into school. Finally, we are asking for a £1.00 cooking donation to help buy ingredients for our weekly cooking sessions, thank you to everyone who has donated already it has been a great support.
