The children have had another busy week of learning and are still very interested in their baby photos that they have been brought in over the last few weeks and are now proudly on display- there have been many fascinating discussions about them between the children and other adults who come into our classroom.

In phonics, we have learnt all of the set three Read, Write, Inc sounds and I have uploaded some teaching videos onto our Google classroom for you to look at and practice with your child. Over the holiday, please log onto our Google classroom as I will upload the set two and some of the set one sounds teaching videos for you to practice with your child.

The children absolutely loved the theatre show on Wednesday. They came back and told me all about it and how amazing it was. It was so wonderful to see them full of joy and they all could tell me their favourite part.

This week, in Science we have been learning about the process of metamorphosis (the structural change of an animal) in a butterfly. We also talked about other animals that had a similar life cycle to a butterfly and this caused lots of interesting discussion!

There was plenty of fun on Thursday as the children made lots of Jubilee items and learnt about the 1970s. We found that lots of cool things were invented and made during this decade and the children were excited that some of these items were still used in their own homes today. We have also been completing a time line for Queen Elizabeth II and Sir David Attenborough, as they are the same age and both known to the children. Sir David Attenborough is also our significant person that we are learning about in History as he was born in Isleworth.

After the half term break we will be starting our last topic of the year...*Seaside*, sadly there will not be any trips to the seaside! However, if anyone is going away during the half term or going to a beach if you could share some photographs with us we can use them as part of our teaching. To remind you Book Week begins when we come back to school and we are going to create an alphabet book of stories. The children's holiday homework would be to create an A to Z book of story books titles. We will use the children's holiday homework to add a picture to each story title to create an alphabet book of stories.
