We hope that you had a lovely bank holiday weekend and Eid Mubarak to all of the families who celebrated Eid-Al Fitr on Monday. This week, the children were pleased to see Mrs P back in the classroom and as some of you may be aware we started to administer the Key Stage One assessments in small groups and will continue to do so throughout the month of May.

In Maths, we continued learning about Fractions. We learned that a unit fraction will always have 1 as the numerator, whereas a non-unit fraction has a numerator greater than 1.

In English, we wrote a recount about our trip to Windsor Castle last week. The children wrote some fantastic recounts. They remembered to use time conjunctions (first, next, later, finally), emotive language to describe how they were feeling and wrote in the past tense. Be sure to read some of their writing on the next page.

In science, we started our topic *Living Organisms and their Habitats* by leaning to identify the seven characteristics of living things, the children were taught to remember these characteristics by learning the acronym *Mrs Nerg*. At home to support your child's learning you could discuss and research a little more about the seven characterises of living things, which are: Movement, Respiration, Sensitivity, Nutrition, Excretion, Reproduction, and Growth.
