Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, it has been very exciting as the children have had two dress up days, on Tuesday we had our Pirate Day and on Thursday we celebrated the Queen's Diamond Jubilee by wearing red, blue and white clothes.

In Maths, we have started our Measurement unit and been learning to measure using non-standard units and standard units of measure. We measured items found in the classroom using equipment like cubes, paperclips and dienes. Later on in the week, we began to compare different heights and lengths by ordering them. We also started to use rulers to accurately measure the length of an object and have learnt that we must always start at zero.

In English, we wrote our own poems about Queen Elizabeth II thinking about our choice of descriptive language, such as the adjectives and similes we used to describe the Queen. The children also tried hard to use repeated phrases and rhyme in their poems. Later on in the week, we performed our poems to the rest of the class.

It was fantastic to see all the children dressed up as pesky pirates on Tuesday! Thank you for all your support with your child's costumes! We spent the day taking part in a range of pirate activities. We made pirate hooks, maps and ships. In the afternoon, the children created art pictures of ships sailing in the ocean. The children said that their favourite part was the treasure hunt! The children loved scouring the playground for chocolatey treasure!

On Thursday, the children enjoyed learning about the Queen, performing poetry and creating silhouettes of her majesty. It was lovely to see many of you at the family picnic after school! Please see some pictures taken throughout the week overleaf.

Remember to read daily with your child and sign their reading records.
