Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had such fun over the last few weeks even though it has been extremely hot! Last week, the children worked together and came up with the idea of making a swimming pool, after they had finished making it we all had a go and used it to keep cool!

We have continued our Supertato story by making our own traps to capture Evil Pea and he has been very mischievous in our classroom this week by popping up in the most mysterious of places! We have been talking about where fruit and vegetables come from and a lot of the children discussed how they come from Asda or Tesco. To help the children understand that fruits and vegetables do not only come from shops we planted our own seeds and discussed where they may have originated. We have also tried eating some different vegetables and talked about which was our favourite.

This week, we have also read *Norman the Slug with the Silly Shell* and we were very lucky that Norman came to visit us, but he was stuck as the sun was shining so he couldn't make any slime. We know that slugs and snails are nocturnal because the sunlight can dry their body which hurts them as they travel along the rough, dry ground. We discovered the difference between slugs and snails and in the story Norman is a slug but he wants to be a snail so he uses a doughnut as his shell. We finished the week by reading a recipe to make our own doughnuts before eating some- they were very yummy!

Next week, we will continue to think about Norman the Slug with the Silly Shell and we will be exploring things that fly. We will even find out why Norman makes a pair of wings using some underpants!

As the weather is warming so too is the Nursery classroom, at times it can get very hot inside. We've noticed that many of the children are wearing multiple layers of clothing, we would like to advise you that you may wish to consider dressing your child wearing less layers to help keep them cool.
