Dear Parents and Carers,

Wow...I am sure that you would agree that this morning class assembly was a phenomenal and faultless performance- well done to all of Year Two!

In Maths this week, we have begun a new unit called **Position and Direction** and have learnt that the term position means where an object or someone is and the term direction means the way something has moved. The children enjoyed, working in pairs, to give a simple command to make their partner travel or change direction. At home to support your child's learning you can give each other commands for example: turn a quarter turn clockwise or turn a half turn anti-clockwise.

In English, we have had a busy week learning about the difference between informal and formal language. We learnt that an author mainly uses informal language whilst writing a fictional book; for example, when a character is speaking, and uses formal language to write a non-fiction text such as an information book, newspaper article or letter. For homework, please find attached a short piece of text to read and identify five informal words that have been used and rewrite them using formal language. I would then like you to write a sentence for each of the words you have identified.

<b>Gonna</b> = going to	Girl, I'm gonna miss you
<b>Wanna</b> = want to	I wanna hold your hand
<b>Gotta</b> = 've got to/a	You gotta be my girl
<b>Gimme</b> = give me	Gimme your heart, babe
<b>Lemme</b> = let me	Lemme take you home
<b>I'ma</b> = I'm going to	I'ma be ok without you
<b>Outta</b> = out of/to	She got me outta my mind
<b>Kinda</b> = kind of	You're my kinda girl
<b>Dunno</b> = don't know	I dunno how to love you
<b>Shoulda</b> = should have	I shoulda told you
