Please be reminded that we are a nut free school.

Children who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction.

If someone has a nut allergy it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nut or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

No nut products are to be in lunch boxes or brought into the school as snacks or treats.

For example:

- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Chocolate spreads
- Cereal Bars
- Some Granola Bars
- Cakes, biscuits/Cookies that contain nuts
- Sauces that contain nuts

Extra polio vaccine dose for children in London

There are signs polio may be spreading in London and the number of children vaccinated in London is lower than it should be. Boosting immunity in children should help protect them and reduce the risk of the virus continuing to spread. For some children this may be an extra dose on top of their routine vaccinations. In other children it may bring them up to date with their routine vaccinations. Please see attached information on where you can get your child vaccinated if they are aged 5-9 years old.
