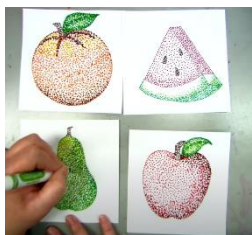
Year Two Homework and News

Dear Parents and Carers,

What an exciting week the children have had! We have been spectacular scientists and learned a lot about the science of jelly!

In writing, we wrote our own poems about the Great Fire of London, and then the children performed their poems; they were so confident and clearly performed their poems.



In Art, we have been creating pictures in the style of Georges Seurat. We drew fruits and used dots to colour them in, this is called **pointillism**.

In Maths, we have continued with our addition and subtraction unit. We have been adding by making ten and adding 3 1-digit numbers. We have been using different yet effective ways to add numbers.

In Science, we observed how jelly changes and hypothesised what will happen to the powdered jelly. We have hypothesised and wrote up our findings. I was impressed with the children's use of scientific vocabulary and hypotheses. We learned that jelly has a fibre called pectin in it, which helps trap the water to form a gel. Have a look at some of our pictures and work.

In Design and Technology, we learned about vehicles by recognising that a vehicle has wheels and transports people or objects from place to place. We also drew and labelled different vehicles. Next week we will compare, draw and label fire engines. This will help us when we design our own engines before we make them next week. However, we will need some additional resources to create our fire engines, so please can you ensure that you bring in your materials before Thursday. **Also, if you have a fire engine toy that we could use to compare to other fire engines please bring them in for Monday.**

This week the whole school is taking part in a music competition about Stevie Wonder. At home, please create a poster about him thinking about:

- who he is
- the songs and genres of music he plays
- the awards he's received
- you may wish to include some art drawings of him
