
Dear Parents and Carers,

What another exciting week in Year Two! We have been designers and creators, and shown perseverance in all areas of the curriculum, so well done to all of you! This week, as a school, we have been deepening our understanding of bullying as part of 'Anti-Bullying Week'.

We have learnt that the most important thing to do is 'reach out' if you or someone else is being bullied. We learned that bullying can be face to face and online, but it is always important to speak to someone about it.



In Maths, we have been adding and subtracting across 10. We have been learning effective ways to subtract 1-digit numbers from 2-digit numbers. For example, 13 – 7. The best way to solve problem similar to this is by subtracting 3 first and then 4. Our key questions have been: How many do you need to subtract to get 10 and how many more do you need to subtract?



In Design and Technology, we started off by comparing different fire engines and labelled parts of a fire engine. Then, later on in the week used our designs to create our fire engines. Next week, we will be evaluating our fire engines and discussing any improvements that could be made. Have a look at some of our work.

In Geography, we have been learning about the UK and the countries in the United Kingdom. We have taken a closer look at the map of the UK, and identified the capital cities of: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland

In RE, we have been learning about the importance of remembrance Sunday and why it is important to remember the soldiers who have taken part in battles.
