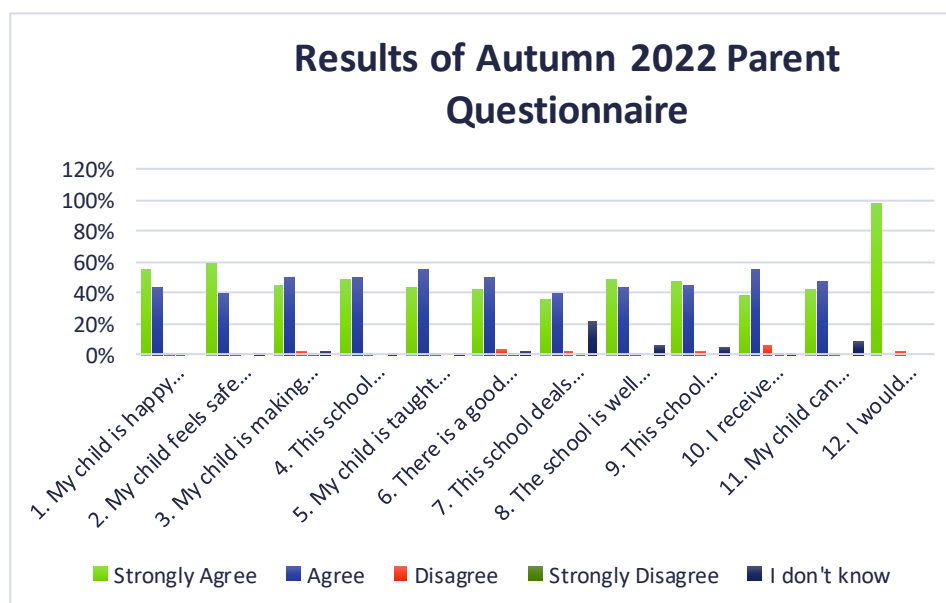

Thank you to the 152 parents (174 entries) who responded to the recent questionnaire that we sent out. We put forward 11 statements and asked for the response to be graded from strongly agree to strongly disagree. We also asked if you would recommend Spring Grove to other parents. This is what we found out:
