Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, we have been learning all about Chinese New Year. We have learnt the meaning of the New Year and how the animals chose the order in which they were named. We watched some videos and talked about how people celebrate Chinese New Year. We made our own spring rolls; many of the children tried them, some liked them and some didn't! We talked about other traditional Chinese dishes and made them from playdough. We practised our chopstick skills and tried to pick up the playdough food- it was trickier than we thought! To end Chinese New Year we watched a New Year display and really enjoyed watching the dragon dance. We made our own dragon head and some of the children used it to do their own dragon dances.

Next week, we will be learning Goldilocks and the Three Bears. I wonder what adventures will await us? It would really benefit the children if they could have some knowledge of the story, so please do visit the local library and borrow the book or find a re-telling of it on the computer for the children to watch if you do not have a copy of the book at home.

This week, you will also receive a letter about Google classroom. This is a virtual classroom that you can access from home. It will be a place for us to share some activities for you to complete at home if you wish and you can share photographs of your children enjoying the activities. We will monitor Google classroom and will respond to your posts in the week.

This week, the children have had the opportunity to play with homemade playdough, two lots of homemade slime and we have made some vegetable spring rolls. Next week, we plan to make some porridge in our learning of the Three bears. However, there are still eight families who have not donated, it is not too late to make you £3 donation.
