Dear Parents and Carers,

We are now only one week away from finishing this term! Well done to all of you for your efforts, keep up the fantastic work.

In Maths, we have now finished the addition and subtraction unit and have been solving a range of addition and subtraction word problems, as well as comparing problems using greater than, less than and equal to. Towards the end of the week started to learn about different shapes and we will be learning about properties of shapes over the coming weeks.

In RE, we have been learning about marriage ceremonies and have wrote about an Asian wedding ceremony thinking about how we can describe it. We learnt about expanded noun phrases, and we tried hard to use these words in our writing: regal, majestic, colourful and colourless, vibrant and dazzling. A noun phrases is when you use two adjectives (describing words) to describe a noun. For example: the regal, intricate gown.

During milk and fruit time we have been reading 'The Day the Crayons Quit' and 'The Day the Crayons Came Home' by Oliver Jeffers. The children have been eager to create their own version of the stories. Next week, in English we will be planning and writing our own stories. Please spend time over the weekend talking and jotting down any ideas for your own story, for example: The day the Teachers quit, the day the Parents gave up or the day the toys woke up.

The children enjoyed wearing their Christmas jumpers on Thursday a huge thank you for your contributions that will be donated to the charity- Save the Children.
