



## Attendance

Good attendance and punctuality is critical in terms of children achieving their best at school. The government set a target of 96% for pupil attendance and we aim to have as many of our pupils in school for at least 96% of the time.

We have introduced an Attendance Cup that is presented every Monday to the class with the highest attendance rate for the previous week. Here are the results for this term so far:

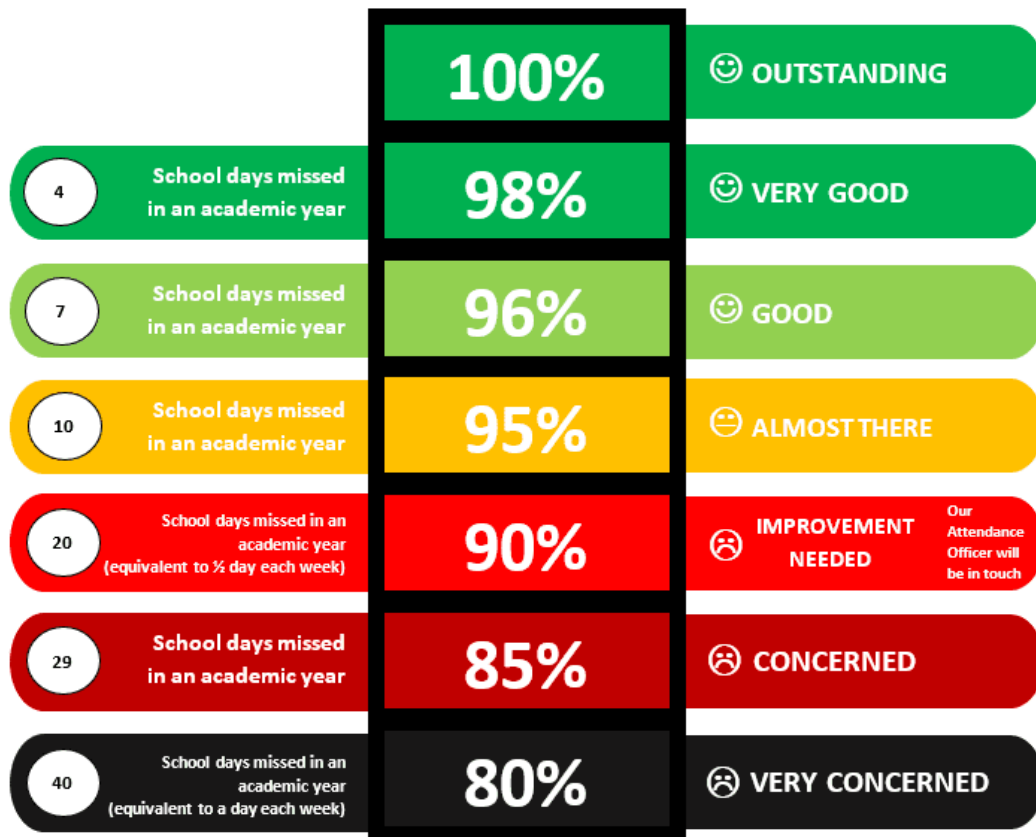
