Happy Friday! We hope that you have all had a lovely week. Thank you to all of those parents who attended parents evening. If you have any questions of would like to discuss anything further, please do come and speak to me.

In maths, we have finished the unit Length and Height and have now began the next unit-Volume and Capacity. We have been learning to measure in millilitres and litres. The children enjoyed measuring liquids, and we were really impressed the accuracy the children showed whilst measuring. We have learned that capacity is the maximum amount a container can hold and volume is amount inside the container. Next week, we will be revising addition and subtraction.

In English, we have continued with our story **Leaf** and have written an information sheet about how polar bears have adapted to live in their environment. We learnt that when writing a non-fiction piece of writing we must use accurate adjectives because it is a factual piece of writing. Our spelling rule this week is 'dge'. Please practise the spellings.

In PE, we have been using tennis rackets to send and receive a soft ball. The children worked in pairs to Play games using tennis rackets. We also continued with our yoga unit, and the children have got a lot better with their focus and balances. We have been working hard on our breathing techniques.
