Life at Spring Grove has been even busier than usual this half term as we have had to administer the national **SATs** papers for **KS1** and **KS2**. We have been very proud by the attitude, focus and determination of all the children to do their personal best.

Year 6 in line with all other state schools in England, sat their tests last weeks and followed a national timetable. All papers have now been collected and are in the hands of external markers. We expect to get the results mid-July and these will be recorded on the end of year school report to parents.

Children in **Year 2** have almost completed their **KS1 SATs** in English and Mathematics. Unlike the KS2 SATs, there is no national timetable tests as schools administer them over a four-week period in May. Staff in school mark the KS1 papers and the results will be published on the end of year school report to parents.

Pupils in **Year 1** will take their **Phonics Screening test** in June as well as pupils in Year 2 who did not meet the expected level last year. Results will be available on the end of year school report to parents.

Children in **Year 4** will be taking their **Multiplication Times Table Check** early in June. Please keep practicing so that recall is as rapid as possible.

Year 4 Trip to Thames Young Mariners

Pupils in **Year 4** enjoyed a residential trip at the start of this week to **Thames Young Mariners** in Ham. They stayed overnight on Monday evening and experienced sleeping in tents and enjoying water-based activities. They were all very well behaved and were great ambassadors for Spring Grove. 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Mathematical Success at Spring Grove Primary School





Children in years 5 and 6 took part in the 'Primary Maths Challenge' which is a nation-wide competition run by the Mathematical Association.

We entered 34 children across Y5 and 6. Each child did tremendously well and each child scored enough marks to be awarded a bronze, silver or gold certificate. Once the entries from each school were submitted, the children who scored at least 21 out of 25 were entered into the 'Bonus Round.' 12 children were entered. Between them, we managed to attain 5 bronze and 3 silver awards. We are so proud of our amazing mathematicians! Well done!
