Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, we have continued to celebrate the Kings Coronation. At the beginning of the week, we talked about how some of the children celebrated over the weekend and others talked about what they saw. We have been thinking carefully about what the King wants to do for the country. We know that he wants us to help and look after each other, nature and the world. We have thought about how we can look after the world and tied this into our interest in watching the bin men each week collecting the recycling and rubbish. We have thought about recycling, why we recycle and what we could reuse instead. We have watched some videos to aid our discussions and we have enjoyed playing in a recycling centre, which the children made outside and we have been sorting different materials. You could support this play by encouraging the children to help you sort your recycling. Talk to them about what is going in the bin and why. Some of the children have expressed an interest in making something new from something old at home, for example: using recycled boxes to make a car or rocket.

Next week, we will continue with our topic of people who help us and will be learning all about builders and mechanics. We will be using the woodwork table to make things using hammers and nails, and we will also be reusing some materials such as bottle tops. If you have any bottle tops at home please collect them for us- it could be milk bottle tops, jar lids (metal or plastic) etc. We look forward to sharing what the children make with you.
