Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, we have based our learning around the book *Supertato*. We have learnt the names of various vegetables, discussing which ones we like the taste of and which we do not, and we have observed different vegetables decaying. We have also hunted for 'evil pea ', enjoyed acting out and made up our Supertato stories. We have explored the different words in the story and tried to use them as part of our everyday play and talk. We have used words like: distress, rescue, vanish and leap. We even found some vegetables trapped when we came into Nursery one morning – we spent a long time trying to release them! We have learnt about speech bubbles and we have been thinking about what each of the vegetables might be saying at different points of the story.

We loved the visit to the farm yesterday- the children had such big smiles on their faces! We were able to go in the pen with the sheep, fed the sheep and the goats and hold the guinea pigs, rabbits and tortoises. The farmer told us all about the animals and we enjoyed being up close and personal with the animals. Thank you all for your support in allowing this to go ahead. This should hopefully be a fond memory for the children.

The weather has been hot this week and we have found that a lot of children are still wearing vests to school. It does get hot in Nursery so we advise that your child wear less layers when the weather is as hot as it has been. Sun cream should be **applied before the children** come to school. **If your child stays all day** and you would like it applied again for the afternoon session please send in some sun cream in a named bottle and we will support your child to apply their own cream at lunchtime.

As you are probably aware, the firefighters were unable to visit us last half term due to attending to an emergency. Their visit has been rescheduled for Monday 19th June. Can we please ask that our morning children stay with us until 12pm because of the timings the fire fighters are able to visit us. If there are any problems please do speak to one of the Nursery team.

We have of course been talking about the men in our lives this week and why we love them. Nursery would like to say **thank you** to all the special men in their lives and we hope you enjoy the cards that they have made you!

On Tuesday 4th July Nursery will be holding their graduation assembly. This will be an opportunity for us to celebrate the lovely year that we have had and say 'good luck' to all the children and 'goodbye' to those leaving for new schools. We will then hold a mini sports event afterwards and we invite our parents to watch. Timings will be approximately 9am untill 10:30am (at the latest).
