Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, in Maths we have continued leaning about fractions, with a focus on quarters. We have looked at how a quarter is written as a numeral, how many equal parts a whole is cut into (4) and how 2/4 is a half. We challenged the children to detectives and spot that 2/4 or two quarters is equal to a ½ or half. We continue to use the words numerator (top number) and denominator (bottom number), the denominator tells us how many parts the whole is divided into.

In English, we are continuing to read *Herb the Vegetarian Dragon*, last week we thought of questions to ask the characters in the story, ensuring that we started our sentences with a question word (who, where, when, what and how) and used a question mark at the end of the sentence. This week, we have looked at answering the children's questions from the perspective of the character.

In Science, we have continued to identify two types of trees, deciduous and evergreen, and their leaves. We have also been labelling different parts of the tree. In addition to this, we have been looking at animals and their babies with a focus on the names of the babies.
