
Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy Eid to all our families celebrating, we hope that you have had a have a wonderful time. Please note that our class assembly has been postponed until Thursday 13th July at 9.10am to enable more practice time as there have been a number of children absent from school this week due to their families celebrating Eid.

Sports day is on Thursday 6th July, starting at 9:15 and we invite all our families to watch their children on the school field. The children in Year One will need to wear their normal PE kits.

In maths, we have started our next unit which involves using numbers 50-100. We are still developing our understanding and applying our knowledge of number to cross a tens barrier for example, 59 – 60. You can help practice this at home and discussing what happens to the tens and ones digit. We have also been counting in tens to a hundred and back again and we are currently working on partitioning 2 digit numbers into tens and one, for example 34 is 30 and 4 or 3 tens and 4 ones.



In English, we are still being inspired by the text *The lighthouse keepers lunch* and this week we have been thinking about what the seagulls are saying about Mr Grinling's lunches.

With the warmer weather please can all children bring in a sun hat and a water bottle with their name on so that they can keep hydrated throughout the day.
