
Year Two Homework and News

This week, we have continued with our current topic and have been administrating the end of Key Stage One Assessments (SATs), we now only have the maths assessments to complete.

In English, we have continued reading Traction Man and been writing about Traction Man who appeared in our reading corner! I have been so impressed with the range of complex sentences and descriptive language the children have used.



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In Maths, we have continued learning about fractions and have been recapping some of our number and place value skills. Our next unit will be time, please begin to look at a clock and count in intervals of five. In Science, we headed outside into the playground and found some microhabitats. We learned that a microhabitat is a very small, specialised habitat, such as a clump of grass, fallen log or a space between rocks. Next week, we will be learning about woodlice microhabitats and we will be trying to answer the question: what conditions do woodlice prefer to live in?



In History, we have learnt about the famous pirate Blackbeard, whose real name was Edward Teach. We learned about his life before he became a pirate. Next week, we will be learning about a female pirate and we will compare their lives.

In PE, we have been continuing developing our athletic skills and have learnt how to hurdle ensuring that whilst taking off and landing we do so on two feet.

In Art, we have been continuing with our still life drawing unit and we headed out into the playground to sketch a still life of the trees and plants that are around our school field.
