Welcome back, the first two weeks of the Summer Term have been busy and the children have been working very hard!

In English, we have started reading the book *Traction Man by Mini Grey*. We have made predictions and have used descriptive language to describe different illustrations from the story. We have been using prepositional language, expanded noun phrases and pronouns. We will soon be writing our own version of the story which will be set in our classroom!

In Maths, we have started learning about fractions and began by identifying half, quarter and thirds of shapes and amounts ensuring that each part is equal! We will be continuing with our fractions unit next week, and we will be focusing on finding fractions of different amounts, for example: 1/2 of 16.

In Art, we have been learning about our focus artist Carolyn Brady, and we have been looking at some of her work before drawing an object found within our classroom to create our own still life sketches.

Mrs Sanchez and I would like to take the opportunity to say well done to all of the children for being focussed and making good choices whilst on our Woburn Safari Trip. The children were respectable and inquisitive.







Next week, we will begin to administrate the Key Stage One statutory assessments and will continue to do so throughout the month of May. These assessments will be woven into our weekly timetable, ensuring that the children continue to have a fun filled, broad curriculum.
