Key Areas of Learning

English

Maths

As mathematicians we will continue to develop the skills needed to use the most efficient strategies whilst calculating.

We shall also be converting units of measure and learning about imperial units of measure, ratio, algebra, fractions, decimals, percentages, area, perimeter, volume, and statistics.

We will also be focusing on problem solving for all the areas we will be learning.

Computing

As computational thinkers and adventure gamers, we will break down, solve problems and create simple codes.

As advertisers we will promote healthy living and we will continue to develop our skills using Word and Excel.

PSHE

We are learning all about dreams and goals. We will be thinking about our personal learning goals and the steps required for success. We will also identify problems in the world and what we can do to help make the world a better place.

PE

As dancers we shall be performing a series of dance actions. Whilst playing dodgeball, we will develop our skills in agility, teamwork, and speed. We will be ensuring honesty and using our listening skills during all our PE lessons.
