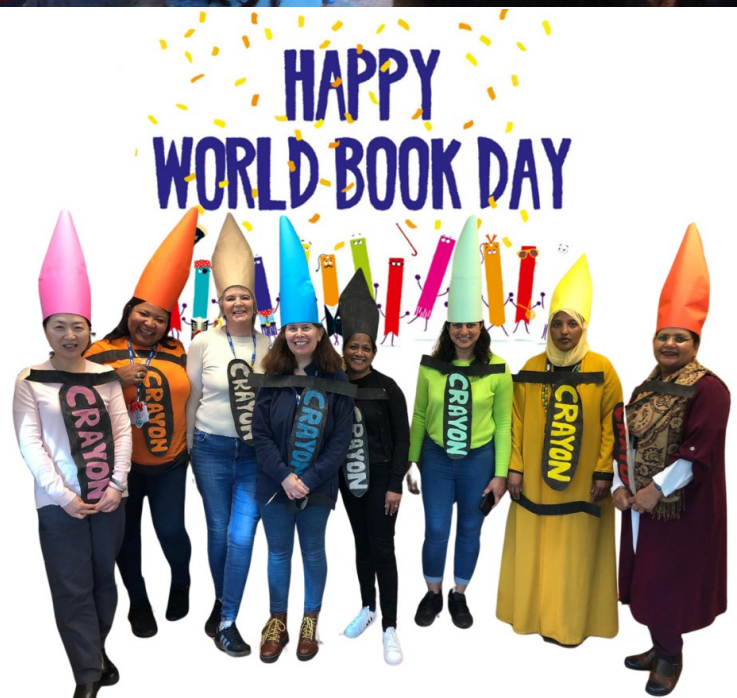
Monday 10th March 2025
