Latest from Year 2 Grey...

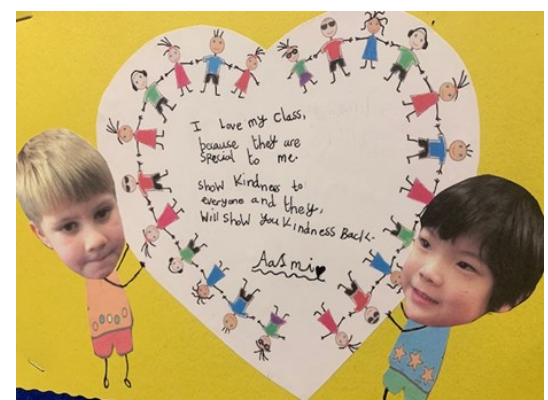
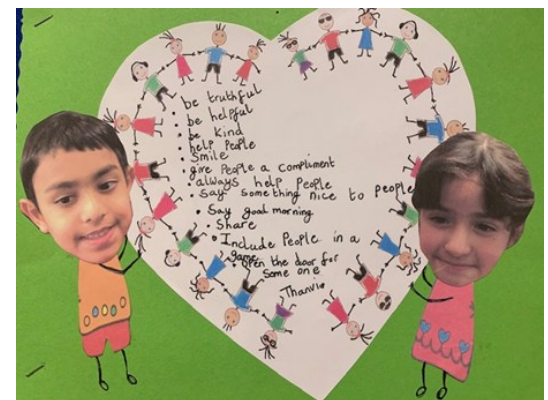
It has been a great start to the new term for Year 2; the children have come back from the Christmas break well-rested and ready to learn. We have started our term with lots of focus on PSHE and setting goals for the new year. We have talked about what we have achieved already in Year 2, comparing what we knew at the start of the academic year to what we know now. This has helped us set our new goals and thinking about the steps we need to achieve them. We talked about not being able to do things YET; we know that things can be challenging but all we can do is show resilience and try our very best. Look at some of the goals we have set for ourselves in Year 2:
