Key Areas of Learning

As historians, we will be researching about Noor Inayat Khan and Sophia Duleep Singh. We will be finding out about them both and comparing their lives to answer the question: Are all princesses the same?

As geographers, we will identify the world's oceans as well as look at symbols on maps and will learn what they represent. We will also be looking at weather in the UK and how it affects our lives. We will be completing some fieldwork using the school grounds, exploring and finding out about our local area and creating our own maps with symbols.

As scientists, we will explore, identify and describe living things and their habitats. We will be able to identify different things and be able to describe if they are living, dead or never lived. We will look at animals in different climates thinking about how they have adapted to live in them. Building on from our previous learning, we will look at some animals' diets and create simple food chains.

English

The books that we will be using as our stimulus for writing will be *Traction Man*, *Hummingbird*, *Abe and Alba* and *A Songbird Dreams of Singing*.

As writers, we will be inspired by the texts we have read to write character descriptions, our own version of the stories, letters, news reports and poems.

Some of us will be continuing with our daily Read Write Inc sessions. The rest of the class will have weekly group guided reading sessions as well as further developing our comprehension skills.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be deepening our understanding of fractions and we will be looking at fractional amounts of a quantity or shape. We will add and subtract fractions and place a given fraction on a number line. We will be learning to tell the time to the nearest five minutes as well as learning to read and interpret timetables, charts and pictograms. We will also describe movement and turns with position and direction.

Throughout the term, we will consolidate our number and place value understanding as well as rehearsing the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

Computing

In computing, we will become onscreen pirates, creating and programming our very own pirate themed sprite. We will also look at data collection and different ways to represent our data.

Art and DT

As creator, in DT we will be finding out about mechanisms and how we can make things strong and stable. We will also be introducing links between art and music using rhythm to inspire art work.

PSHE

In PSHE, we are learning about relationships thinking about what it means to be part of a family, and why it is important. In our Changing Me unit, we will be thinking about some of our physical and emotional changes that are taking place.

RE

In RE, we will continue to learn about Islam and the importance of the prophet Muhammad to Muslims as well as the importance of the Qur'an.

PE

In Physical Education, we will be developing lots of different skills in golf, and our invasion games and target games units. We will also be looking at different athletic disciplines and developing our running and throwing skills.

Music

As musicians, we will be exploring how music makes us feel and how music makes you want to dance. We will also be improvising and creating our own piece of music.
