It is hard to believe that in ten school days' time the school holidays will start. I hope that you all have some relaxing and fun activities to look forward to.

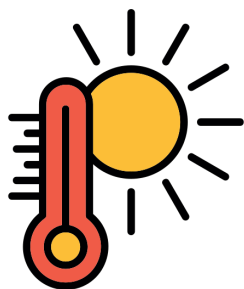
We will be cramming a lot into those ten days so it will be a very busy couple of weeks. Please see the table of dates on **Page 4** for further information.

We have new role play areas in our classroom. An ice-cream shop outside and a toy shop inside.

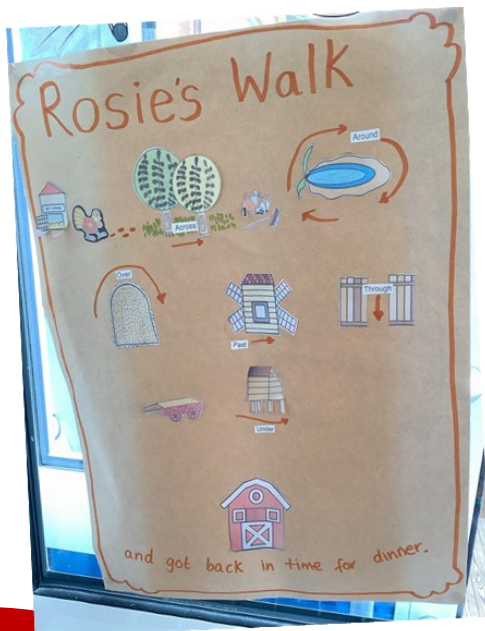
The children have learnt how to write shopping lists starting each sentence with 'Can I have...' and made price labels and signs for the items for sale. We are remembering how to count 1p and 2p coins and are using this knowledge in our play.

Later in the term we will learn about how ice-cream was made in the past using ice houses and we will test an ice house out for ourselves, looking at ways to keep ice cold, not very easy in Summer!



Our P.E topic this term is team games, with a focus on hand and football skills. We have been having our P.E lessons outside in the Arena where there is a lot more space.

In English we learnt the story of Rosie's Walk. We acted out, learnt actions for all the different prepositions, drew and wrote the story. Our next focal story is **What the Ladybird Heard** by **Julia Donaldson**.
